## **Flamenco Universal's Grant Program**

Flamenco Universal, a 501(c) (3) non-profit organization, was founded in 2001. Our mission is to promote the art of flamenco music and dance, through public performance, instruction, and cultural enrichment programs.

To fulfill the second part of this mission, Flamenco Universal offers grants to enable students to study flamenco music and dance. To date we have offered grants totaling over \$11,000.

Grant programs are largely sustained through tax-deductible contributions to our scholarship fund. To donate, please enquire at the postal address or email address above.

### **Who should apply?**

You must be either:

- ❖ A student of flamenco who lives in the North Bay or North Coast counties of California and wishes to continue study with the teacher of their choice regardless of location.
- ❖ A teacher of flamenco who wishes to continue his or her own study or otherwise enhance their ability to teach flamenco to their students.
- ❖ Teachers should not apply on behalf of their students.

### **When should I apply?**

- ❖ Application forms received prior to June 30 will be evaluated and decided upon in July. Funds will be disbursed early in August.
- ❖ Applications received between July 1 and November 30 will be evaluated and decided upon in December and funds will be disbursed early in January.
- ❖ Grant monies are to be used for the stated purpose within a year of their receipt.

### **How much can I request?**

Ask for what you need. Small requests are encouraged; larger requests may be granted in part.

### **Where can I get a form?**

You may request an application by writing to the above postal address, or to info@flamencouniversal.org. Forms are also available at on the Web at flamencouniversal.org.

### **Is there anything else I should know?**

- ❖ The board may request further information, such as an audition or recommendations from your teachers.
- ❖ Grant requests will be considered by the Board of Flamenco Universal on an individual basis.
- ❖ The Board may consider merit, need, and the availability of funds in deciding whether to make a grant or not.
- ❖ The final decision on any request rests with the Board, which may or may not give reasons for its decision.
